1 Prepare installation

☐ ☐ Log in as user².

☐ Install Debian-package kz³:
 Press the key⁴, type **term** and click the **Terminal** icon.
 Type these two commands, each followed by the key:
`wget karelzimmer.nl/getdeb`
`bash getdeb`
 Follow the instructions on the screen.

☐ ☐ Prepare the installation:
 Press the key⁴, type **menu** and click the **Installation menu** icon.
 Select **1 Prepare installation**.
 Follow the instructions on the screen.

1 LTS stands for Long-Term Support, and this April 2022 Ubuntu 22.04 LTS Desktop (codename jammy) will be supported for 5 years until April 2027, and with an free personal Ubuntu Pro subscription for 10 years until April 2032.

2 Login any additional users and follow the same steps.

3 Package kz contains scripts for installing and managing Debian and Debian-based systems such as Ubuntu.

4 The key is the Windows key, Command key (Apple), or Magnifier key (Chromebook).

2 Perform installation

- ☐ Boot the computer from¹ an Ubuntu 22.04 LTS Desktop Live² USB stick³.
Select **Try or Install Ubuntu**.

- ☐ Click **Install Ubuntu**.

Follow the instructions on the installation screens.

- ☐ At **Who are you?:**
Enter your **Your name** user,
Your computer's name computername,
Pick a username username, and
enter a **password** twice.

- 1 Boot menu/Setup via one of the frequently used keys: `Esc`, `Delete`, `F1`, `F2`, `F9`, `F10`, `F11`, or `F12`.
- 2 From a Live USB stick you can boot and work with Ubuntu without modifying any files on the hard drive and also allows installation of Ubuntu.
- 3 Create a bootable USB stick:
Download a CD image file (.iso) from ubuntu.com, click consecutively **Download** > **Get Ubuntu Desktop** > **Download 22.04....**
The next steps are described in **Linux information**, which can be found at karelzimmer.nl, under **Linux**.

3 Finish installation

- ☐ Log in as user.
- ☐ Follow the instructions on the welcome screens.
- ☐ Add any additional users with the following steps:
 - Press the Super key¹, type **user** and click behind **Settings** on **Users**.
 - Click **Unlock** and enter password.
 - Click **Add User**.
 - Choose **Account Type**, **Standard** or **Admin**.
 - Enter **Name** user and **Username** username, and click **Add**.
 - Close the **Users** screen.
- ☐ Install updates:
 - Press the Super key¹, type **upd** and click the **Software updater** icon.
 - If updated software is available click **Install Now**.
 - Follow the instructions on the screen.
- ☐ Install Debian-package kz²:
 - Press the Super key¹, type **term** and click the **Terminal** icon.
 - Type these two commands, each followed by the Enter key:
wget karelzimmer.nl/getdeb
bash getdeb
 - Follow the instructions on the screen.
- ☐ Complete the installation:
 - Press the Super key¹, type **menu** and click the **Installation menu** icon.
 - Select **3 Finish installation**.
 - Follow the instructions on the screen.
